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PROGRAM INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS

INCENTIVE LIMIT

Cash incentives are limited to \$350,000 per project and \$750,000 per customer in a calendar year for all Focus on Energy incentives (prescriptive and custom). Any project with an expected incentive exceeding \$25,000 must receive written approval BEFORE project initiation or equipment purchase.

PRESCRIPTIVE INCENTIVES

Cash incentives are available for a variety of technologies. Check the Focus on Energy Web site at focusonenergy.com/incentives/business or call 800.762.7077, then press #2 for more information. Depending on your business tax classification, the IRS may require you to pay taxes on incentives totaling over \$600 per calendar year.

- Compliance:**
 - All projects are expected to comply with federal, state and local codes.
 - All equipment must be new. Used or rebuilt equipment is not eligible for incentives. Existing equipment must be removed.
 - Equipment must meet specification requirements and be purchased and operating prior to submitting an incentive application form.
 - Only one incentive will be granted for each project. Incentives granted to contractors, distributors or other market providers cannot also be claimed by end-use customers.
- Payment:** Once completed paperwork is submitted, incentive payments are made within 6–8 weeks. Incomplete applications will be returned.
- Inspection:** Program staff may conduct an inspection of the facility to survey the installed projects.
