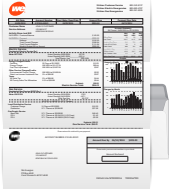


Next steps

Your bill will continue to be calculated using current rates until new rates are approved by the PSCW.

The PSCW will conduct a thorough review of our proposal and will hold a public hearing at a date, time and location to be determined.

After taking our information and public testimony into account, the PSCW will set new rates. They may be higher or lower than what we requested.



If approved, we anticipate new electric, natural gas and steam rates will take effect in January 2027.

Learn about our **2027-2028 rate proposal**

Wisconsin Electric Power Co. and Wisconsin Gas LLC (doing business as We Energies) filed a proposal on April 1, 2026, with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW) to set 2027-2028 rates for electric, natural gas and steam utility operations. This insert provides an overview of our request.



Our commitment to you

The PSCW will decide the final amounts and set new rates. The impact of the requested increase on your bill will vary depending on your rate class and amount of electricity, natural gas and/or steam you use.
